Prophecies of the Messiah in Isaiah

THE PROPHECIES OF THE MESSIAH

- He will be born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14)
- He will have a Galilean ministry (**Isaiah** 9:1-2)
- He will be an heir to the throne of David (**Isaiah 9:7, 11:1, 10**)
- God's Spirit will rest on Him (**Isaiah** 11:2)
- He will judge the earth with righteousness (**Isaiah 11:4-5**)
- Gentiles will seek after Him (**Isaiah** 11:10)
- He will have His way prepared (**Isaiah** 40:3-5)
- He will be spat on and struck (**Isaiah** 50:6)
- He will be exalted (**Isaiah 52:13**)
- He will be disfigured by suffering (**Isaiah 52:14, 53:2**)
- He will make a blood atonement (**Isaiah** 53:5)
- He will be widely rejected by the people (Isaiah 53:1-3)

THE FULFILLMENT IN JESUS

- He was born of a virgin named Mary (Luke 1:26-31)
- His ministry began in Galilee of the Gentiles (**Matthew 4:13-16**)
- He was given the throne of His father David (**Luke 1:32-33**)
- The Spirit of God descended on Him (Matthew 3:16, Mark 1:10, Luke 3:22, 4:1)
- He was given authority to judge (John 5:27, Luke 19:22, II Timothy 4:1, 8)
- Gentiles came to speak to Him (John 12:20-21)
- His coming was announced by John the Baptizer (John 1:19-28)
- He was spat on and beaten (Matthew 26:67)
- He was highly exalted by God and the People (**Philippians 2:9-10**)
- He was scourged by Roman soldiers who gave Him a crown of thorns to wear (Mark 15:15-19)
- He shed His blood to atone for our sins (I Peter 1:2)
- He was not accepted by all (John 12:37-38)

Prophecies of the Messiah in Isaiah

<u>THE PROPHECIES OF THE MESSIAH</u>

- He will bear our sins, sorrows (**Isaiah** 53:4-5)
- He will be our substitute (**Isaiah 53:6-8**)
- He will voluntarily accept our guilt and punishment for sin (**Isaiah 53:7-8**)
- He will be silent before His accusers (**Isaiah 53:7**)
- He will be buried in a rich man's tomb (Isaiah 53:9)
- He will save us who believe in Him (Isaiah 53:12)
- He will die with the transgressors (**Isaiah 53:12**)
- He will heal the brokenhearted (**Isaiah 61:1-2**)

THE FULFILLMENT IN JESUS

- He died because of our sins (Romans 4:25, I Peter 2:24-25)
- He died in our place (Romans 5:6-8, II Corinthians 5:21)
- He took on our sins (John 1:29, Romans 6:10, II Corinthians 5:21)
- He was silent before Herod and his court (**Luke 23:9**)
- He was buried in the tomb of Joseph, a rich man from Arimathea (Matthew 27:57-60, John 19:38-42)
- He provided salvation for all who believe (**John 3:16, Acts 16:31**)
- He was numbered with the transgressors (Mark 15:27-28, Luke 22:37)
- He healed the brokenhearted and intercedes in prayer (Luke 4:18-19, Romans 8:34, Hebrews 7:25)
