



<u>CONCLUSION</u>: I want to close by reading **Psalm 95:1-7**. When we stop listening to God terrible things will happen. Listening to God is very important (**Isaiah 35:5, 55:2-3, Romans 10:17**), but it is also very important to listen to others (**Romans 10:14, James 1:19**). Jesus emphasized the need to listen throughout His ministry. Listening is good for the soul. Do you have an attentive ear to those around you (**Acts 15:12**)? Are you listening to the Lord (**Luke 9:35**)? Are you obeying His Word (**Luke 6:46**)? It is time to listen up!
